Dear Business Owner:

On August 27th, Chicagoland Paving Contractors will begin construction on the 2018 Prospect Avenue Resurfacing Project. The location of this work will be on Prospect Ave. from Park Ave. to Railroad Ave. as well as Park Avenue between the east and west sections of Park Ave. The work occurring this week includes saw cutting and removal of spot sections of existing curb and sidewalk, and then framing and pouring back the removed curb and sidewalk. Once the curb and sidewalk is poured back, the concrete needs to be cured 3 days before that area may be reopened. Construction hours for this work will typically begin at 7:00 am and end by 6:00pm on Monday through Friday and if Saturday work is required, work hours are from 8:00am to 4:00pm. However, to accommodate issues that may arise with parking and rail/pedestrian/motoring traffic, construction hours may be amended to possible early starts. If early morning work does occur, a notice will be delivered in advance.

During construction, no business entrances or sidewalk near businesses will be closed. When the contractor is constructing curb and gutter, parking spots near business fronts will be **closed off** and **"No-Parking"** signs will be placed in front of the affected spots. During removal work, spots will be closed off and then reopened as soon as the area has been fully barricaded and cleaned up. Once the curb is poured and finished, parking spots will be open but please refrain from parking on the curb line as the concrete needs the full 3 days to cure.

Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. We will do our best to keep you notified with locations for temporary parking and any possible changes in the construction schedule. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.
