Prospect Ave. Resurfacing Project

Week of 8/27 – 8/31

- On Monday, August 27, 2018, crews began curb removal of the west side of Prospect Ave. along with curb and sidewalk removal on the Triangle on Prospect Ave. Work began at 7:00 AM and crew completed west side of street by 3:30 PM.
- Curb removal for the east side of Prospect Ave. along with two small sections on Park Ave. across from the Triangle is expected to take place on Wednesday, August 29th, 2018. During this time, parking will be closed on the east side but parking will be available on the west side of Prospect.
- Between Thursday, August 30th and Friday, August 31st concrete crews will complete forming, pouring, and stripping forms for the curb and sidewalk work.
- **No work will occur during Labor Day Weekend from Saturday August 30th to Monday, September 3rd.**
- During curb and sidewalk forming and pouring, parking spots near the curb to be replaced will be temporarily closed while the work is being completed. The spots will be reopened when work is complete and the area is clean.

Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm on Monday through Friday. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.
