Prospect Ave. Resurfacing Project

Week of 9/10 – 9/14

- On Tuesday, September 11th, the contractor will pave the 1st lift of asphalt on Prospect Ave./Park Ave. Construction hours for this work will begin at **6:00 am** to pave the intersections at Park/Prospect before morning traffic begins to increase.
- During the paving operation, the road will become a **one way road** with either northbound traffic closed off or southbound traffic closed off temporarily. The closures will most likely be only for a few hours and during these closures there will be detour signs guiding motorists around the closed off section. Also, during the paving operation, **all parking will be closed off** until the area is clean and the paving is fully complete. Once the operation is fully complete, parking will be available again
- Before the paving work begins at **6:00am**, Chicagoland Paving will apply a liquid prime coat to the roadway. This work will begin around **1:00 am** and will last approximately two hours. This work should not disturb residents and will be done one lane at a time. “Fresh Oil” signs are currently posted to notify motorists of the application of the liquid prime coat.
- Between September 12th and September 13th – Galaxy Underground will be adjusting manhole, valve vault, and catch basin frames in the roadway. Crews will be working in the driving lanes at times throughout these days so please take caution and follow flagging instructions when driving downtown.
- On September 14th, Chicagoland Paving will pave the final lift of asphalt of Prospect Ave./Park Ave. For the final lift of asphalt, Prospect Ave./Park Ave. will be **fully closed** to motoring traffic. Detour signage will be set up at Prospect Ave. and Railroad Ave., Park Ave. and Railroad Ave., Park Ave. and Walker Ave., and Prospect Ave. and Harris Ave. This full closure will allow work to be completed efficiently and ensure the best product for the roadway surface.

Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm on Monday through Friday. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.
