**Prospect Ave. Resurfacing Project**

**Weeks of 9/17 – 9/21**

- On Monday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, Galaxy Underground will be adjusting manhole, valve vault, and catch basin frames in the roadway. Crews will be working in the driving lanes at times throughout these days so please take caution and follow flagging instructions when driving downtown.
- On Wednesday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, Chicagoland Paving will pave the final lift of asphalt of Prospect Ave./Park Ave. Construction hours for this work will begin at **6:00 am**. For the final lift of asphalt, Prospect Ave./Park Ave. will be **fully closed** to motoring traffic. Detour signage will be set up at Prospect Ave. and Railroad Ave., Park Ave. and Railroad Ave., Park Ave. and Walker Ave., and Prospect Ave. and Harris Ave. This full closure will allow work to be completed efficiently and ensure the best product for the roadway surface. The closure will most likely be only for half the day. During the paving operation, **all parking will be closed off** until the area is clean and the paving is fully complete. Once the operation is fully complete, parking will be available again.
- On either Thursday, September 20<sup>th</sup> or Friday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, Gallagher Asphalt will be completing the decorative imprinting work for all five crosswalks on the intersections of Prospect Ave./Park Ave. as well as the north and south crosswalk at the intersection of Park Ave. and Railroad Ave. During this work there will be a moving lane closure with detour signs guiding motorists around Prospect Ave. The moving closure will allow the material to cool and cure completely.

**Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm on Monday through Friday. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.**
