

Part-Time Maintenance Worker I

The Village of Clarendon Hills, IL (pop. 8,540) is accepting applications to fill one part-time Maintenance Worker I position. Clarendon Hills is located in DuPage County approximately 17 miles west of Downtown Chicago and is between the Villages of Westmont and Hinsdale.

The Maintenance Worker I is responsible for semi-skilled maintenance and repair work of the Village's infrastructure. Work involves performance of a variety of tasks including the repair of Village streets, water mains, parkways, buildings, and similar facilities. Work includes the operation of motorized equipment and vehicles and the expenditure of heavy physical labor. Work takes place indoors and outdoors.

Applicants must possess a valid Illinois Driver's License, CDL is required after 3 months of employment. Applicants must be able to lift and/or move up to 50 pounds on a frequent basis. Must also be able to successfully pass a pre-employment medical exam, including a drug screen, and a criminal background check.

The starting pay for the position is \$22.37 per hour.

The part-time Maintenance Worker I typically works 29 hours each week and will have opportunities to receive more hours and overtime pay throughout their tenure.

Benefits include vacation, sick and personal leave and the Village will assist the selected individual in securing certifications needed to advance their career. Position is IMRF eligible.

Applicants must have:

- Valid Illinois Vehicle Operators License
- Ability to obtain a Commercial Driver's License within 3 months of employment
