### **2017 Water Main Improvements Update**

The work has been progressing a little ahead of schedule. The work along Naperville Road from Woodstock to N. Richmond is complete. The new water main was installed on both Traube from Woodstock to N. Richmond and Oxford Avenue from Ogden Avenue to Traube this week. We will start the new water service installation next week on Monday on Traube. The new water service work along Oxford will start no sooner than next Friday, April 21<sup>st</sup>. Local road closures will be in place along the streets we are working on each work day from 7:00am to 5:00pm. To complete the remaining water service work a shutdown for the affected residents will be scheduled. After the new water services are completed we have two final water main connections to make that will require shutdowns, but the affected residents will be notified the day prior. **We anticipate completing the water main project by April 28<sup>th</sup>.**

This work requires us to restrict the affected streets to be No Parking on both sides while the water main work is ongoing on that specific street. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted where needed and we ask for your cooperation to park elsewhere. We ask the affected residents to inform their visitors, contractors, landscapers, nannies, cleaning services, etc. to park in your driveways or on adjacent streets during active construction on your block. Temporary Road Closed signs may be set up at each end of our construction zone to detour through traffic around the active construction zone.

**Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm on Monday through Friday. Saturday work may be approved on a case by case basis by the Village depending on weather and progress. We will notify the bus company and the trash company of our active construction zones and we will coordinate with them to get your trash picked up on Tuesdays. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.**
