2017 Water Main Improvements Update

The water main work along Naperville Road from Woodstock to N. Richmond is complete. The water main work along Traube from Woodstock to N. Richmond is complete. The contractor will be installing new water services along Oxford from Ogden to Traube on Monday, April 24th. On Tuesday, April 25th they have their final water main connection to make along Ogden and Oxford. Oxford will be closed except to residents only on Monday, April 24th and Tuesday, April 25th. We will begin next week water jetting the new water main trenches to facilitate their settlement. This work will not impact the residents. **We still anticipate completing the water main project by April 28th.**

This work requires us to restrict Oxford to be No Parking during the work day on both sides while the water main work is ongoing. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted where needed and we ask for your cooperation to park elsewhere. We ask the affected residents to inform their visitors, contractors, landscapers, nannies, cleaning services, etc. to park in your driveways or on adjacent streets during active construction on your block. Temporary Road Closed signs will be set up at each end of our construction zone to detour through traffic around the active construction zone.

Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm on Monday through Friday. Saturday work may be approved on a case by case basis by the Village depending on weather and progress. We will notify the bus company and the trash company of our active construction zones and we will coordinate with them to get your trash picked up on Tuesdays. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.
