**2018 Road Improvement Program**

**Weeks of 8/6- 8/17 Woodstock and Oxford Avenues-**

- Tuesday 8/7 at 7:00am the work associated with the new concrete shoulder on Oxford (east side of street) going north from Burlington to Chicago will begin. Later that morning they will move to Woodstock (west side of street) going south from Chicago to Burlington.
- Wednesday 8/8 they will be setting up string line and begin the process to pour the new concrete shoulders on both streets. We anticipate the contractor finishing this work on Thursday, August 9<sup>th</sup>. After that, they will begin to remove and replace the concrete driveways along the new concrete shoulder on both streets. This work is expected to be completed on Monday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. Replacement of the asphalt driveways will then be completed in the following two – three days. **We estimate re-opening the driveway aprons on Friday, August 17<sup>th</sup>.** A notice will be provided to the affected residents on when they can use their driveways again. The asphalt replacement will be a two-lift (two-layer) operation and residents can drive on them after the first lift (layer) goes down. After completing the concrete driveways they will begin to pour the sidewalks and crosswalks on those same side of the impacted streets.
- The contractor anticipates starting the ditching work along Arthur and Tuttle between Chicago and Burlington this week. They will work around the normal residential use of the streets. Please stay away from the active construction zone because it may be difficult to drive through. We anticipate this work to last into next week. Sod placement will occur after Labor Day when the weather conditions are more suitable for the sod to survive.

As you know the Village has made Woodstock and Oxford one-way streets, **northbound only**, during this construction. At times during active construction you may need to go in the opposite direction away from the active construction zone to leave your home or to return. Please be cautious and patient. Parking restrictions will be lifted on streets impacted by the construction. You need to have Village vehicle stickers on cars parked along the Village streets.
