**Prospect Ave. Resurfacing Project**

**Week of 9/4 – 9/8**

- The milling of the existing roadway on Prospect Ave./Park Ave. is scheduled for Friday, September 7<sup>th</sup>. The contractor plans on **starting at 6:00 am** to mill the two intersections at Prospect Ave./Park Ave. before morning traffic begins to increase.
- During the milling operation, the road will be become a **one way road** with either northbound traffic closed off or southbound traffic closed off temporarily. The closures will most likely be only for a few hours and during these closures there will be detour signs guiding motorists around the closed off section.
- Also, during the milling operation, **all parking will be closed off** until the area is clean and the milling operation is fully complete. Once the operation is fully complete, parking will be available again.
- On Monday, September 10<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday, September 11<sup>th</sup>, the contractor tentatively anticipates paving of the 1<sup>st</sup> lift of asphalt on Prospect Ave./Park Ave. The road will once again become a **one way road** with either northbound/southbound temporarily detoured around the closed off section as well as parking being closed off until paving is complete.

**Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm on Monday through Friday. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.**
