### **2019 Water Main Replacement Program**

The construction of new water main and water services has begun and will continue through June 2019. The streets impacted by our work are as follows:

- The intersection of Park Avenue and Eastern Avenue
- The intersection of Holmes Avenue, Harris Avenue, and Eastern Avenue
- Walker Avenue from Park Avenue south to 55<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Prospect Avenue from Park Avenue south to 55<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Harris Avenue from Walker Avenue east to Prospect Avenue.

#### **Week of 3/18:**

- The new water main work was completed on Harris Avenue from Walker east to Prospect Avenue. New water main has been installed on Prospect from Harris Avenue to about 214 Prospect Avenue.
- On Friday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> they will continue installing water main on Prospect from 214 Prospect south to Sheridan Avenue. Prospect Avenue will remain closed during the workday from Harris south to Sheridan.

#### **Week of 3/25:**

- On Monday, March 25<sup>th</sup> the contractor will resume installing water main along Walker Avenue from Park Avenue south to Ridge Avenue. Walker Avenue will be closed during the work day in the active construction zone. They will continue going south with water main construction on Walker Avenue all week while the Walker School is closed for Spring break. They should finish up the water main south to 55<sup>th</sup> Street by Friday March 29<sup>th</sup>.
- **Tuesday's garbage pickup will start at 6 AM in the construction area. Please place your garbage cans outside before 6 AM.**

Due to the planned construction this year on Walker Avenue and Prospect Avenue, a detour route has been developed from Park Avenue to 55<sup>th</sup> Street. The contractors will post this detour route on Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup> to be used by vehicle traffic during this entire construction season from Park Avenue, south to Eastern Avenue, then south on Holmes Avenue to 55<sup>th</sup> Street. The same detour route will be identified for northbound traffic into downtown and the Metra Station. We encourage all residents to use Holmes and Eastern to stay out of the active construction areas. Local road closures will be in place during construction along the streets we are working on each work day from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

A separate and different contract, the 2019 Road Improvement Program, will construct the new streets, driveway aprons and parkway restoration along these same streets and others, but the Road Program is not to begin until mid-June.

**Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Monday through Friday. Saturday work may be approved on a case by case basis by the Village depending on weather and progress. We will notify the bus company and the trash company of our active construction zones and we will coordinate with them to get your trash picked up on Tuesdays. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.**
