

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20-2-3

**EXECUTIVE ORDER REGARDING PLACES FOR TIME OF DELIVERIES TO
ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES
UNDER A DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN
THE VILLAGE OF CLARENDON HILLS, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS
(COVID-19 –2-3, 2020)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Clarendon Hills (the “Village”) is a non-home rule unit of local government, as provided by Article VII, Section 7 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a dangerous disease which has spread around the world, including in the United States, the State of Illinois and DuPage County; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a direct and serious threat to the public’s health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2020, the Village President declared a state of emergency in the Village in Declaration 2020-2, entitled “Declaration of a State of Emergency in the Village of Clarendon Hills, DuPage County, Illinois (COVID-19 – March 18, 2020)” (the “Declaration”); and

WHEREAS, the Declaration was made pursuant to authority granted to the Village President in Section 2.6 of the Clarendon Hills Village Code, entitled “Village President’s Authority to Declare a State of Emergency,” and pursuant to Section 11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-1-6); and

WHEREAS, the Village President has determined that it is necessary to make this Executive Order to best protect the public’s health, safety and welfare regarding COVID-19;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, by the Village President of the Village of Clarendon Hills, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Incorporation. That the recitals above shall be and are incorporated in this Section 1 as if restated herein.

SECTION 2: Executive Order. That it is ordered as follows:

1. That all Village-imposed restrictions on hours of delivery of goods to grocery stores, supermarkets, pharmacies and other essential places of business in the Village are hereby suspended.

SECTION 3: Duration. That this Executive Order shall expire upon the earlier of:
(a) the Declaration ending; or (b) withdrawal of this Executive Order by the Village President;
